Half fare ID cards are available from CAT to persons with qualifying disabilities. Persons under age 65 with a Medicare card qualify for this program. • LOST SOMETHING ON A CAT BUS? Articles found on a bus are kept for 30 days. Call 238-8304 if you lose an article. • CAN'T DO! Smoking, drinking and eating are not permitted on CAT buses. Playing radios, televisions, compact disk players, etc. in a manner that is offensive to any passenger or driver is prohibited. No pets allowed on CAT buses, except guide and service animals. <p>CHILDREN: Age five and under ride free when accompanied by a fare paying passenger.</p>
